Karns Family Retreat

We are slightly less than 5 weeks away from our Karns Family Retreat. Plans are being made and prayers are being offered up for an unbelievable weekend together with our church family. You may be wondering what this retreat is all about. I hope this article helps to explain it and answer any questions you may have. If after this you still have a question, please don't hesitate to ask and I'll do my best to give you an answer.

What is the retreat theme? "We Are Family"

When is the retreat? The retreat will take place on Friday night, September 1st and end Saturday afternoon, September 2nd.

Where is the retreat? The retreat will take place at Lake Frances Retreat Center in Crossville, TN. This is a retreat center that several of us have been to before with our young people.

What time does the retreat begin Friday? You can arrive at any time on Friday after 4:30 p.m. Supper will be served at 7:00 p.m. (Eastern Standard Time). Crossville is in the Central time zone so please be aware the time on your cell phone may automatically change.

What time does the retreat end Saturday? We will wrap up by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday so everyone has plenty of time to arrive back in Knoxville before dark.

Who is the retreat for? YOU! This retreat is designed for every member of our congregation, our church family.

What is the cost for the retreat? The cost is \$50 per person or \$150 for families of three or more. We know this seems like a lot, but the cost per person does not even cover our total expense. For \$50 you will get housing for Friday night plus 3 meals (Supper on Friday and Breakfast and Lunch on Saturday). We will begin collecting the money in a couple of weeks.

What is the purpose of this retreat? To spend time growing in our fellowship and worship as a family of God

When is the sign-up deadline for this retreat? Wednesday night, August 16th.

Please sign up on the appropriate sign-up sheet located on our family board. There will be one for all the guys and one for all the ladies. Each member of your family should be listed so we have a count of how many beds we will be using.

The sleeping arrangement will be cabin style (climate controlled) with cabins for men and cabins for women. Moms who need to be with their young children (male or female) WILL BE TOGETHER! And don't worry about transportation: if you need a ride just indicate it on the sign-up sheet and we will see to it that you get to experience this family retreat.

Please be praying that God is glorified and that we are strengthened and unified.
