Train Up Your Child

We are very familiar with Proverbs 22:6, which states, “Train up your child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not depart from it.” We are also familiar with Ephesians 6:4, which says to bring your children up in the training and admonition of the Lord. What can we do as parents to ensure that we do train up our children properly?

First, exhibit Christian behavior consistently. You can use Romans 12:9-21 and Galatians 5:22-26 as good guides for how we ought to behave in order to be good role models for our children. Be kindly affectionate, be patient, and forgive one another, as a start. Model these behaviors everywhere, not just in the church building.

Are your child’s friends having a bad influence on your child? This is a difficult situation, but Proverbs 13:20 states that the companions of fools will be destroyed. You have a choice. You can try to influence your child’s friends in a positive way and share the gospel with them. If they are unwilling to learn or change their ways, you must restrict your child from seeing those friends. Otherwise your child is at risk.

Finally, you must not forsake the assembling of the brethren (Hebrews 10:25), nor let your child do so. You and your child need to be with your church family as often as possible. Your church family loves you, cares for you, and wants the best for you and your family. Saying that you are letting your child make the decision abrogates your role as parent. Letting your child regularly miss services, classes, and other assemblies allows the world to take control, rather than the Lord.
