- ⊕ "The Paper Chase" (I Cor. 1:20-21).
- ⊕ Research: Biology and Bible (II Tim. 2:15).
- ⊕ Jesus cannot be defeated (Rev. 1:18).

Applications

- ⊕ The World is what it is; it needs an opportunity before it needs judgment (Jn. 3:17).
 - ⊕ Seeker secrets are simple (Jn. 13:34-35; 17:21-23).
 - ⊕ Scissors and integrity beat paper (I Cor. 1:27-2:2).
 - ⊕ Me thinks they do protest too much (Rom. 1:18-22).
 - ⊕ Primary source: the Bible—period (II Tim. 3:16-17).
