

Our Appointment at the Table of Jesus

Acts 20:6-7

- 1. Appointments are important; their importance, however, varies according to the nature of the appointment (I Corinthians 11:27)**
- 2. We have an appointment with Jesus to meet Him at His table (Matthew 26:26-29)**
- 3. The occasion of the appointment speaks to its importance (John 13:1)**
- 4. The remembrance of the appointment speaks to its importance (Corinthians 11:23-25)**
- 5. The appointment is tied to the solidarity of the church (I Corinthians 10:15-18)**
- 6. The appointment is not optional (I Corinthians 11:17-20, 24-25)**
- 7. The appointment energizes four other actions (Giving, singing, praying, preaching)**
- 8. The appointment encourages love and good deeds (Hebrews 10:24-25)**
- 9. The appointment is every first day of the week (I Corinthians 16:1-2; 11:17-20)**
- 10. The appointment is something to work other things around and it sets the tone for additional activities (Acts 20:6-16)**
- 11. Our Appointment at the Table of Jesus (Every Sunday Jesus is present at His table, we have an appointment to join Him)**
