Deuteronomy 12:28

Be careful to listen to all these words which I command you, so that it may be well with you and your sons after you forever, for you will be doing what is good and right in the sight of the LORD your God.

THE MOUNTAIN (EX. 19:9-25; 20:1-17)

- The need for awe
- Reverence is an indispensable part of a relationship with God

THE SMALL VOICE (I KGS. 19:9-18)

- God doesn't have to shout to be God
- The Bible is more about ordinary life than extraordinary experiences

THE WORD OF THE LORD (JER. 1:4, ETC.)

- Men's words have true authority only if they come from the Lord
- God has spoken, we have no excuse

THOSE WITH EARS TO HEAR (MATT. 11:15; 13:9, 43)

- We need to use the appendages on the sides of our head for their intended purpose
- We are not excused for not comprehending

DO YOU NOT YET UNDERSTAND (MATT. 16:9)?

- There are expectations
- Spiritual priorities must prevail

THE WORD WHO IS GOD (JN. 1:1, 14, 18; 14:7-9)

- Difficult to miss the significance here
- A "show and tell" revelation—lest we somehow miss the point
